
Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over.


This guide specifies best practice for freestanding furniture items, such as (but not limited to): Bedroom Storage (over 50cm), Bookcases & Shelves (over 60cm), Storage Units and Modular Cubes (over 60cm), Entertainment Units (over 50cm), Buffets, Hutches & Sideboards (over 50cm), Filing Cabinets & Home Office Furniture (over 50cm), Laundry Shelving (over 60cm) and Garage/Garden Shelving (over 50cm).

To help prevent tip over:

- Place heaviest items in the lowest compartments.
- Unless specifically designed to accommodate, do not set other heavy objects on top of this product.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time (OR)
- Do not defeat or remove the drawer interlock system.

Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.
