


TV UNIT 2 DOORS ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



TIPS BEFORE YOU START

- 1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture.
- 2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commen ce each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
- 3. For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people to assemble your product safely.
- 4. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
- 5. For the protection of your furniture, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
- During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product. 6. Do not use power tools.
- 7. Always place the product on a flat, steady and stable surface.
- 8. Do not stand on the product. Do not use the product as a stepladder.
- 9. This product is intended for indoor, household use only as it is a non-industrial product.
- Please use caution and care when lifting the product to avoid personal injury and/or product 10. damage.


CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR FURNITURE

- $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ To clean your item, please use a damp cloth and wipe clean.
- $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ To clean glass, please use glass cleaner.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or $\mathbf{\Lambda}$ finishes to de-laminate.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Please do not place hot items (eq. hot drinks) directly on to the surface.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Please do not drag and pull your furniture.

ASSEMBLY REQUIREMENTS

- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Equipment: phillips head screwdriver, flat head screwdriver and hammer
- $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ 1 x adults required
- $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ 1m x 1m assembly space required
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ 1 hour assembly time approx.








USING CAM LOCK AND QUICKFIT


QUICKFIT

Tighten quickfit until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten.





CAM LOCK

When fitting cam lock, ensure starting position is correct before you insert connecting quickfit.




Quickfit head should be in the centre of the cam lock when the two panels are joined. Cam lock should be inserted before quickfit.







STEP 1


Insert quickfit screws (B) to parts 3 and 4, as shown.






STEP 2


Insert quickfit screws (B) to part 5, as shown.






STEP 3

Insert quickfit screws (B) to part 6, as shown.





STEP 4

Insert wooden dowels (D) to parts 15.

Fix part 3 to part 15 using screws (A).


Insert cam locks (C) and wooden dowel (D) to part 8.

Attach parts 3 and 5 to part 8, as shown.









STEP 5

Insert wooden dowels (D) to parts 16.

Fix part 4 to part 16 using screws (A).


Insert cam locks (C) and wooden dowel (D) to part 8..

Attach parts 4 and 6 to part 8, as shown.










STEP 6

Insert wooden dowels (D) and cam lock (C) to part 7.

Attach part 7 to part 5, as shown.








STEP 7

Insert wooden dowels (D) and cam lock (C) to part 7.

Attach part 6 to part 7, as shown.








STEP 8

Slide part 9 between grooves of parts 4, 6 and 8.

Slide part 9 between grooves of parts 3, 5 and 8.


Slide part 11 between grooves of parts 5, 6 and 7, as shown.




STEP 9

Insert quickfit screws (B) to part 1.

Fix wall bracket (G) to part 1 using screw (H), as shown.





STEP 10


Insert wooden dowels (D) to parts 3, 4, 5 and 6.

Insert cam locks (C) to parts 3, 4, 5, 6 and 15, 16.

Fix part 1 to parts 3, 4, 5, 6 and 15, 16, as shown.








STEP 11

Slide part 9 between grooves of parts 4, 6 and 8.

Slide part 9 between grooves of parts 3, 5 and 8.


Slide part 10 between grooves of parts 5, 6 and 7, as shown.




STEP 12

Fix handle (E) to parts 12 using screws (F), as shown.

Repeat step twice.






STEP 13

Slide parts 12 into grooves of part 1.






STEP 15


Fix part 13 and 14 to part 2 using screws (H), as shown.






STEP 16

Secure parts 9, 10 and 11 by fixing wedges (J) with screws (I), as shown.






STEP 17


For extra stability, you must fix your TV unit to the wall using the additional hardware (A), (G) and (K), as shown.

Screw (A) is fixed through the bracket (G) and into the wall plug (K).


Should you choose not to affix the product to the wall, serious injury may be caused if the product tips over.

Please consider the wall mounting & fixing guide when securing your TV unit.





STEP 18



Maximum recommended weight is 15 kg on top, 5 kg inside each shelf.

Your TV unit 2 doors is ready for use.
