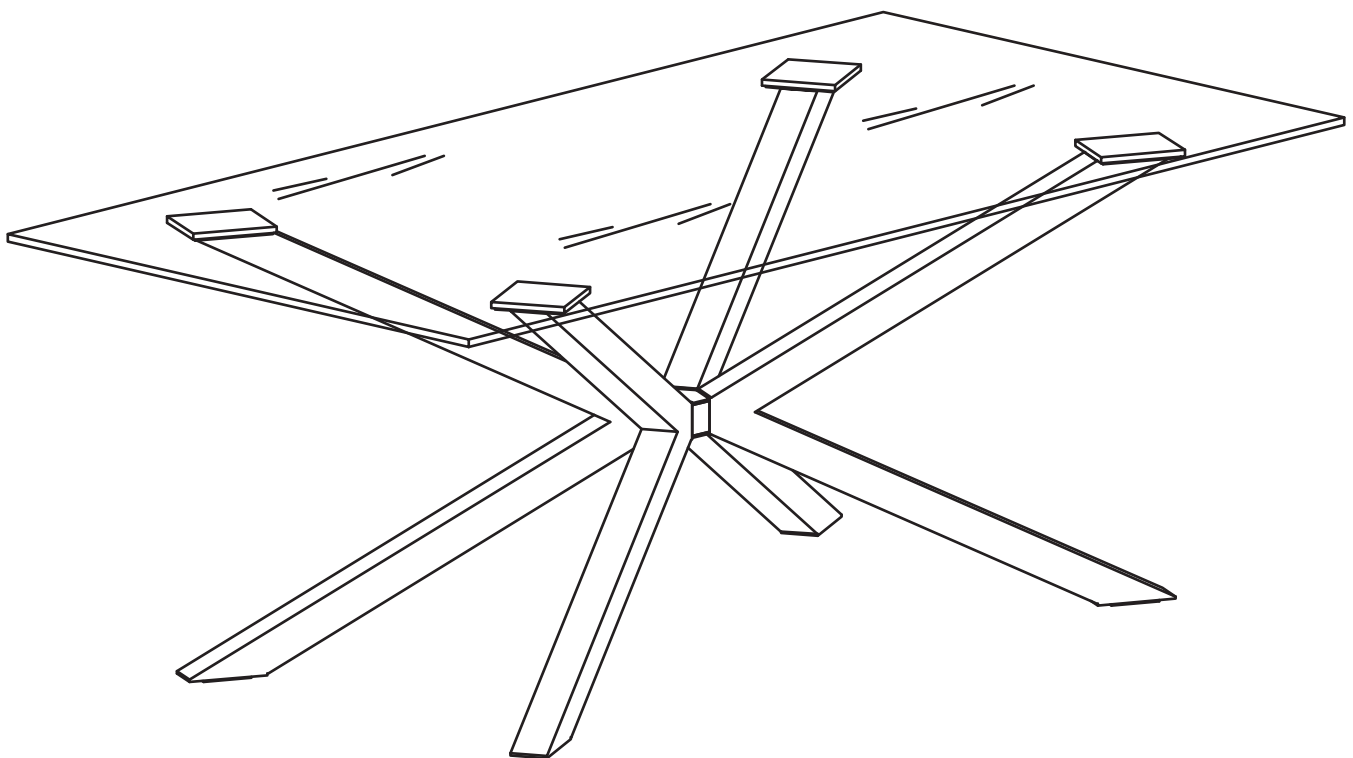


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Keep these instructions for future reference

Assemble the furniture on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the furniture or your floor.

Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

We recommend furniture be assembled near where they will be placed, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.

If there is a need to move the furniture, please remove all loose items and have extra hands to help lift the furniture to the desired location. Dragging the furniture will damage both the furniture and the floor.

Regularly check and re-tighten (if necessary) all bolts on furniture that you have assembled yourself.

Care and Maintenance of your Furniture

Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Use only water or a gentle detergent.
Wipe dry with a clean cloth.

Glass Warning

Keep these instructions for future reference
If the glass is chipped or broken, stop using the product and consult the seller.

WARNING

Do not place very hot or cold items on the glass surfaces unless adequate thick table mats are used to prevent such items from coming in contact with the glass.

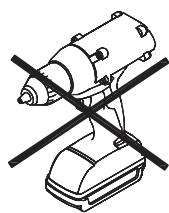
Do not sit or stand upon the glass surfaces.

Do not use the glass as a chopping surface.

Do not strike the glass with hard or pointed items.

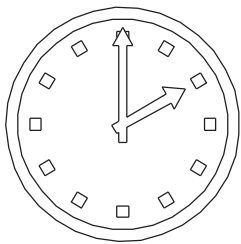
When cleaning the glass panels use a damp cloth with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary, do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives since these substances scratch glass.

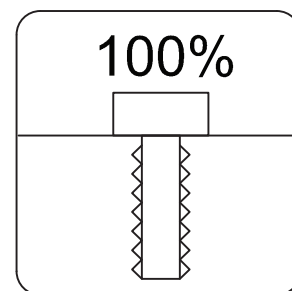
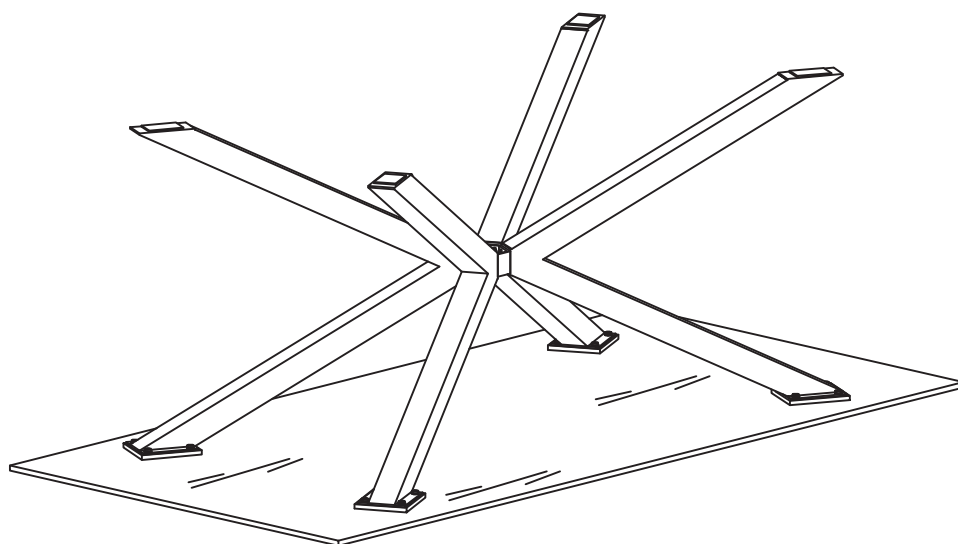
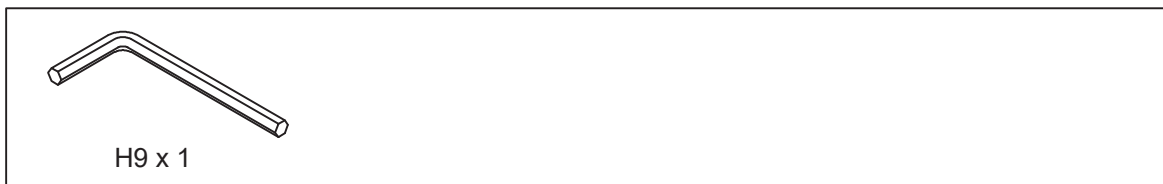
Loosely attach 4 x Legs (P2) to Leg Bracket (H1) with 12 x Bolts (H4), 12 x Spring Washers (H7) and 12 x Washers (H8) using Allen Key (H9).

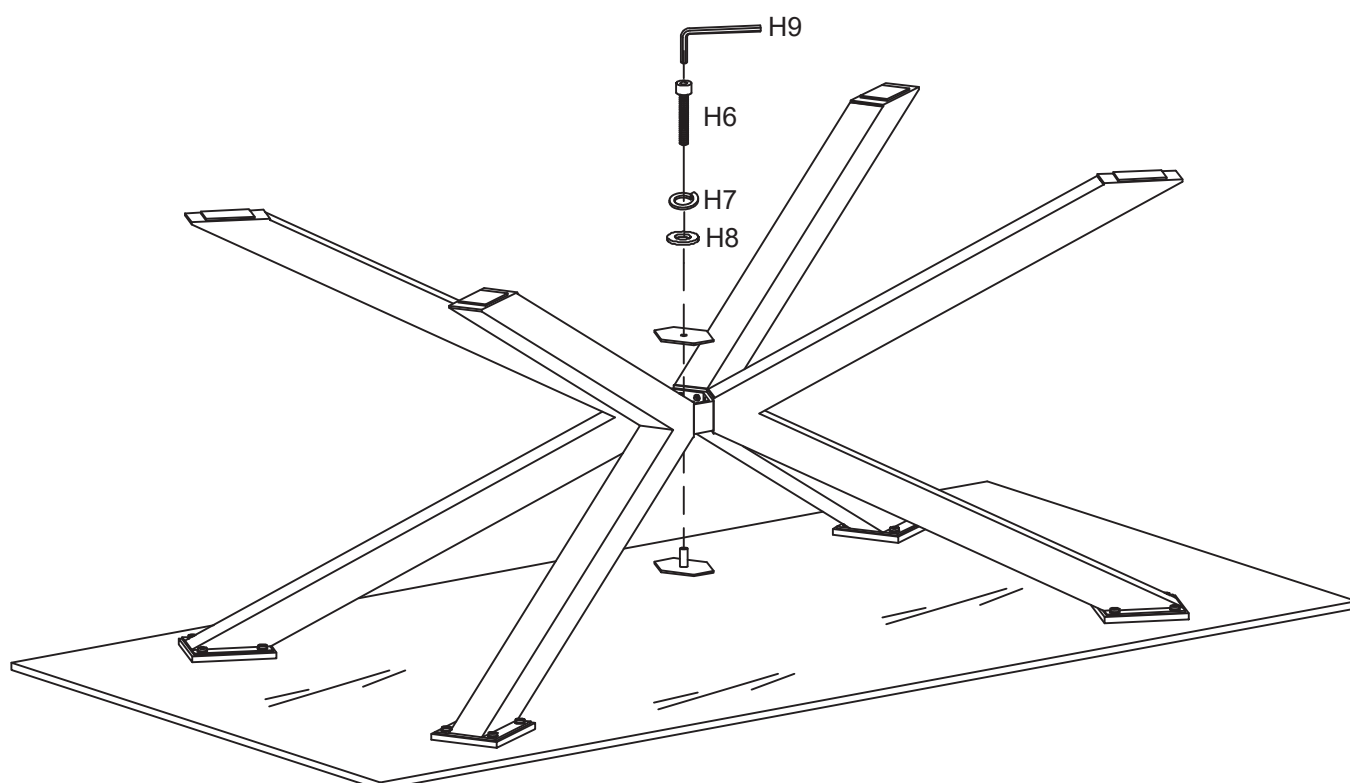
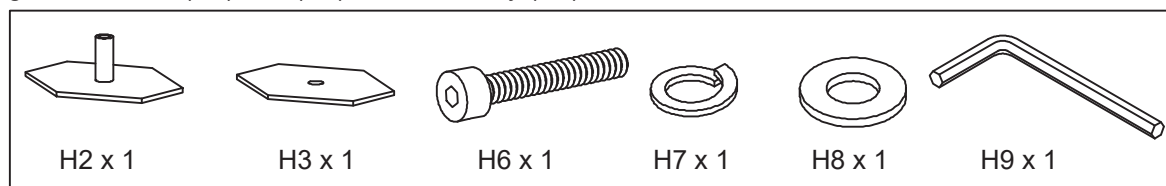
Paste 8 x Felt Pads (H10) to the 4 x Legs (P2).
With help, carefully place the leg assembly onto Glass Top (P1).
Loosely attach the Glass Top (P1) to the leg assembly with 16 x Bolts (H5), 16 x Washers (H8) and 16 x Spring Washers (H7) as shown.

Fully tighten all Bolts (H4) and (H5) with Allen Key (H9).

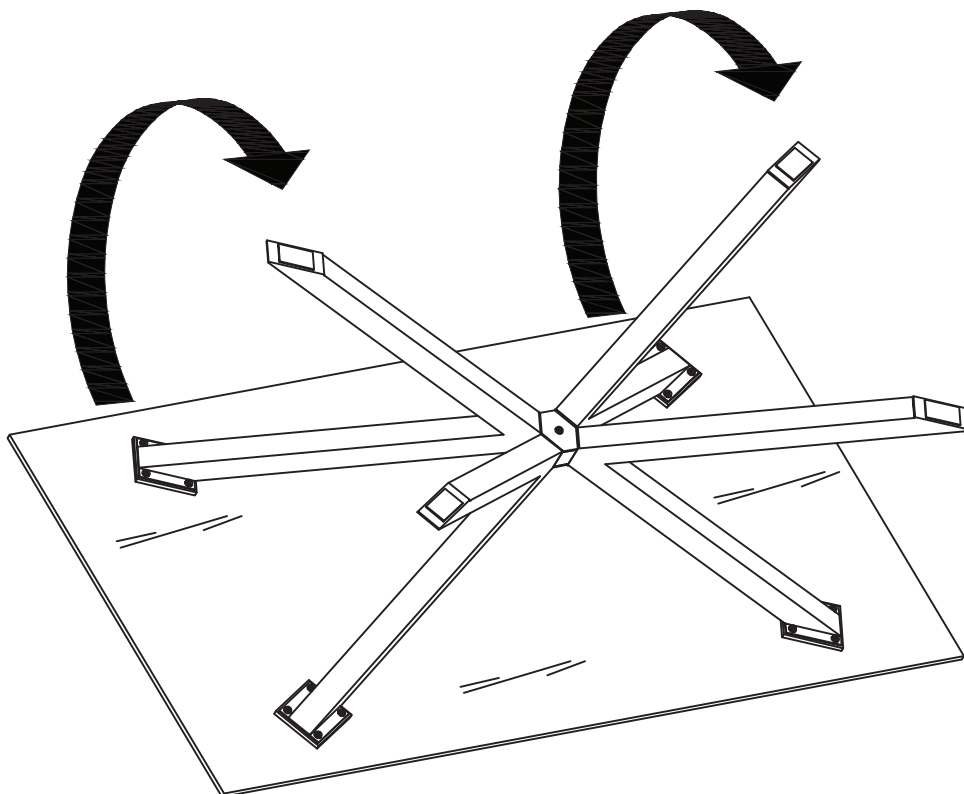

Fix the Bracket Top Cover (H2), and the Bracket Bottom Cover (H3) onto the Leg Bracket (H1) with 1 x Bolt (H6), Spring Washer (H7) and Washer (H8) as shown.
Tighten the bolt with Allen Key (H9).

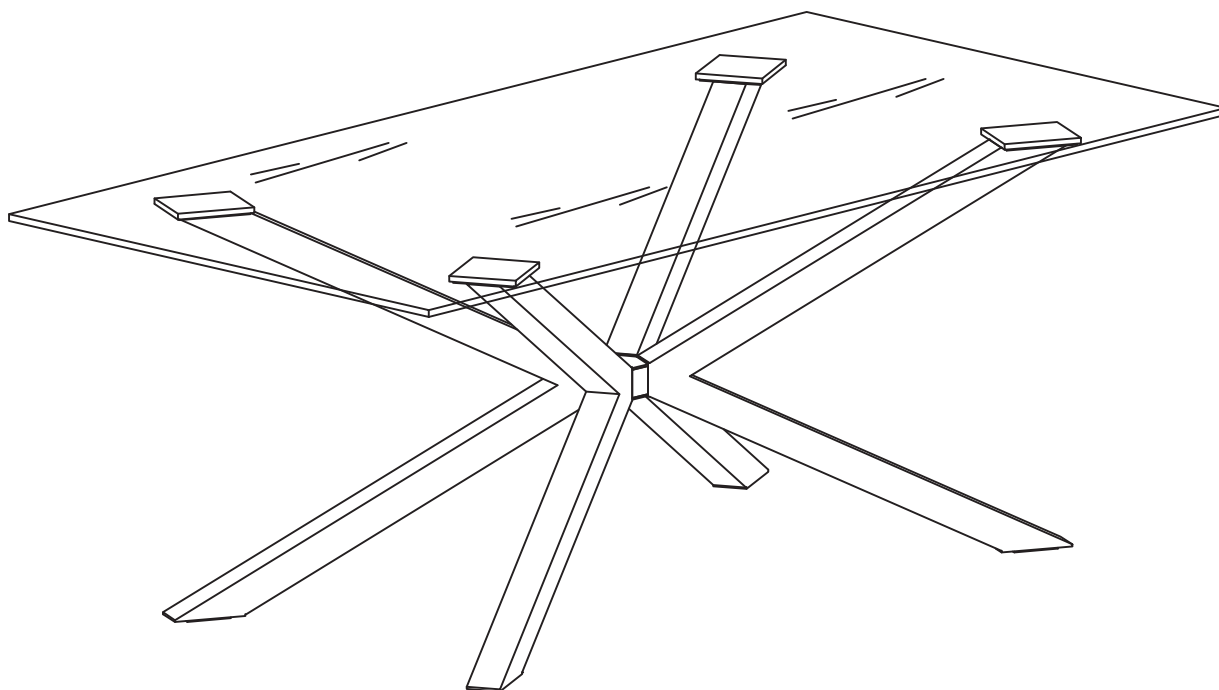
