


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Vera antique-style console table



Keep these instructions for future reference

Assemble the furniture on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the furniture or your floor.

Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

We recommend furniture be assembled near where they will be placed, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.

If there is a need to move the furniture, please remove all loose items and have extra hands to help lift the furniture to the desired location. Dragging the furniture will damage both the furniture and the floor.

Regularly check and re-tighten (if necessary) all bolts on furniture that you have assembled yourself.

Warning: In order to prevent overturning, this product must be used with the wall attachment device provided.

Care and Maintenance of your Furniture

Always use coasters or placemats to protect the table surface, remove any liquid spills immediately using a clean cloth or kitchen roll sheet & mild detergent.

Do not stand on the Furniture



It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that you ANCHOR this product.

Toppling furniture can cause serious injuries and death.

This product has been supplied with a bracket. To prevent your furniture from tipping forward it is strongly recommended that you securely attach this product to a wall or other solid surface, using the brackets provided and appropriate fixings.

IMPORTANT:

Regularly check that anchors are securely maintained.

Use safety drawer locks to prevent children climbing.

Stability of tall items may be affected by thick pile carpet or uneven floors.


Do not place unanchored televisions on furniture.

CAUTION:

For your safety when attaching the anchor fixings, please note the following:

- Check for any electrical wires or plumbing inside the wall before drilling any holes (if you are unsure, please seek professional advice from a qualified tradesperson)
- Walls are constructed from different materials, for example, masonry (solid brick) or plasterboard lined cavity walls (hollow). It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixings for your wall type. If unsure, please seek professional advice on how to attach this safety bracket to your specific wall.
- Your local hardware store will have the necessary drills and fixings and can offer advice if needed. If in doubt, engage the services of a qualified tradesperson to install and anchor the product.



Table Top (P1); Leg (P2)x4.








Hardware/Fittings \emptyset 6mm Ø 8x30mm Ø 16mm M6x45mm Wood Dowel x 8 Flat Washer x 16 Spring Washer x 16 Bolt x 16 3 1 2 Ø 3.5x16mm Ø 20x3mm 75x25x15mm Screw x 4 Felt Foot x 8 Bracket x 2 70 mm Handle x 1 (5) 6 8 (7) Ø 3.5x16mm Screw x 2 4mm Allen Key x 1 10 (9)







Insert 8 x Wood Dowels 1 into 4 x Leg (P2).


If necessary, gently tap the wood dowels with a mallet.




Loosely attach 2 x Brackets 6 to Table top (P1) with 4 x screws 5 using a screwdriver.



Attach 4 x Legs (P2) to Table Top (P1) using 16 x Bolts 2, 16 x Spring Washers 3 and 16 x Washers 4. Tighten the bolts with Allen Key 10.





Attach 8 x Felt Foot \bigcirc to 4 x Legs(P2).
