

Please retain this manual for future reference.


ATTENTION

- This storage rack is intended for indoor use only. Uses that do no tmatch the description or unauthorised change or modification are not permitted. Otherwise, it may result in personal injury or damage to the product.
- The product must be strictly assembled and used in accordance with the provisions of this manual. Please check to ensure all parts are accounted for after unpacking. Please inform our Customer Service immediately if there are parts missing or damaged.
- It recommended that the product be assembled by two competent adults. Please wear gloves when assembling the product to prevent any injury.
- Place the product on a flat and hard surface to ensure its stability.
- Do not attempt to shake the product after assembling.
- The rack should be placed against and fixed to awall. Please use only wall plugs and screws that are suitable for the type of wall. If unsure, consult your local hardware dealer for advice.
- Please keep away from water and electrical pipes when drilling into walls.
- The load on the shelves must be evenly distributed so that no harm can come to the shelves. Never exceed the maximum shelf load for the complete unit array.
- Do not place this rack in a room with hgih humidity to avoid damage to the MDF board shelves.
- Please wipe with a wet cloth and then use a dry cloth to remove all moisture during cleaning.


WARNING

- To avoid the potential danger of suffocation, dispose of all packaging responsibly and keep it away from children.



Tools required for assembly




Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from racks tip-over. To help prevent tip-over:


Secure racks to walls.


Place heaviest items in the bottom shelf
Never allow children to climb on racks.

ASSEMBLY STEPS








STEP 3

C x 2pcs

Put the frames in location and assemble the part C to the frames with a hammer.


Assemble all the parts C to the frame in same way.




STEP 4


Bend the clip of Part E 90° and insert the clip into the slot at the middle of Part C.Then bend the tip another 90° to enable a firm joint between Part E and Part C.
