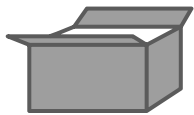

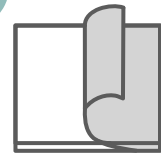

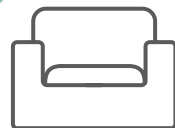

FAQ

What is compressed furniture?

They're vacuum-packed and boxed into a compact size for easier delivery. Once opened, the furniture expands into its intended shape.

What is semi-compressed furniture?

Some parts of the furniture, such as cushions or arms, are compressed or packed flat to reduce bulk for easier delivery, while the furniture's structure remains fully supported and protected.

My furniture is creased – what should I do?

Allow up to 72 hours for your furniture to fully expand. Smooth the fabric with your hands and, for a pristine finish, a light steam iron can be helpful.

Is assembly required?

Some furniture may require light assembly, such as zipping components together to secure them. Generally, no tools are needed.

Can I move it easily?

Yes, compressed furniture is lighter and more compact, making them easier to lift and manoeuvre around your home.

How do I care for my compressed furniture?

Vacuum regularly using a soft brush attachment on a low-suction setting; spot clean with a damp cloth; keep out of direct sunlight to prevent fading over time.
