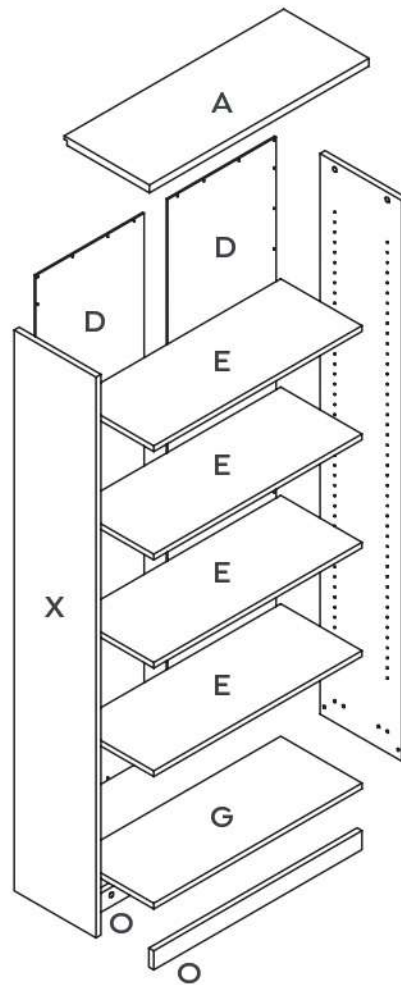

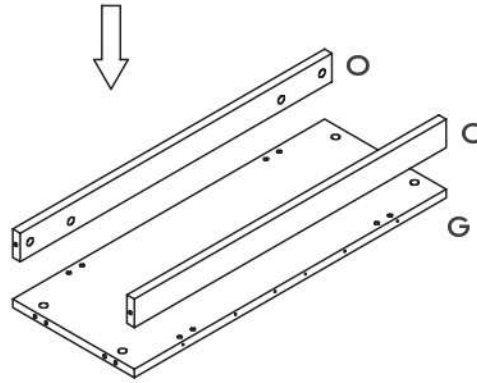
WARNING

- Place heavy items down low.

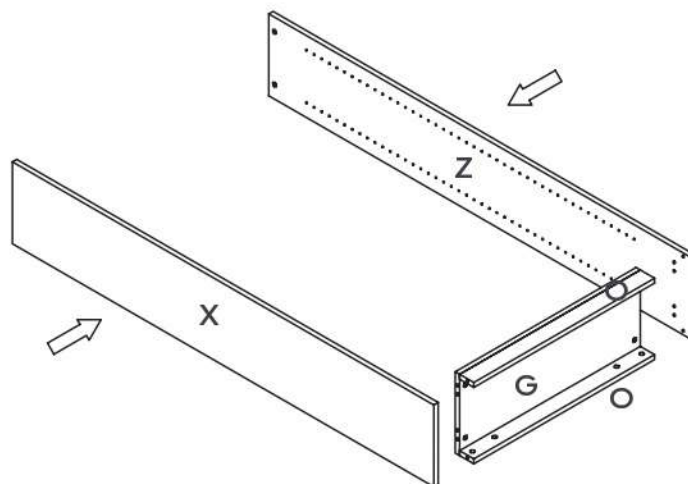
STEP 1:



Preparation for Panels O and G.

1. Connect Cam bolts and dowels on panel O to the holes on panel G and tighten in a clockwise direction as illustrated above.

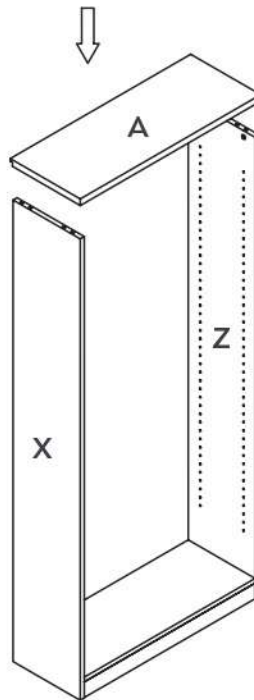
STEP 2:



Preparation for Panels X and Z.

1. Connect Cam bolts and dowels on panel O and G to the holes on panel X and Z and tighten in a clockwise direction as illustrated above.

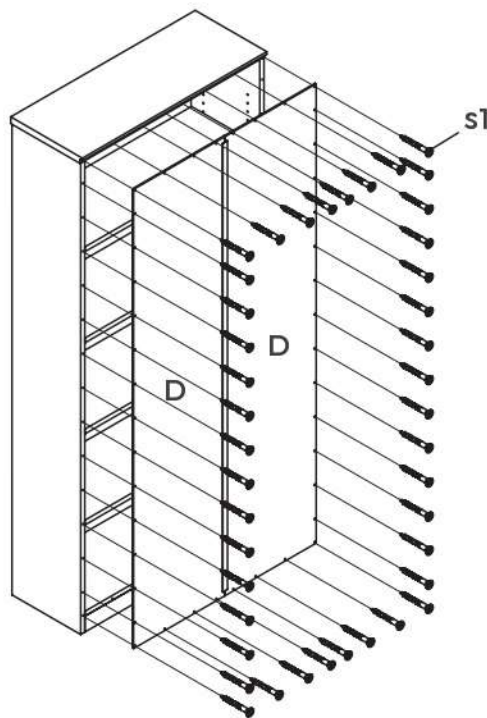
STEP 3:



Preparation for Panels A.

1. Connect Cam bolts and dowels on panel X and Z to the holes on panel A and tighten in a clockwise direction as illustrated above.

STEP 4:

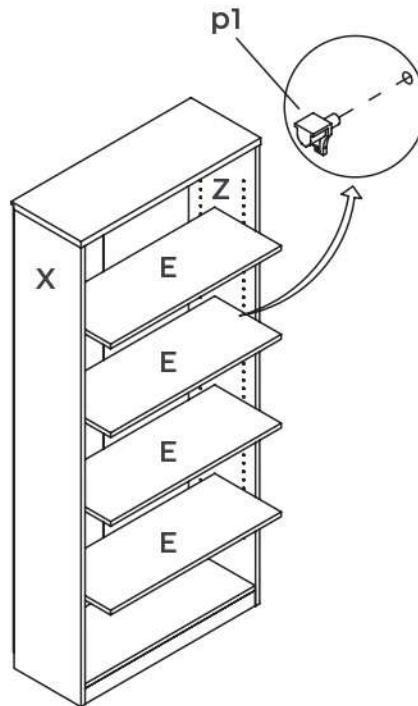


3.5x14 Screw

Bookcase back panel D assembly.

1. Connect back panel D and panel X, Z, G, A with screw (s1) as illustrated above.

STEP 5:



Moveable shelf E assembly.

1. Insert threaded dowel pins (p1) into panels X and Z as illustrated above.
2. Put the two panels E on the top of threaded dowel pins (p1) as illustrated above.

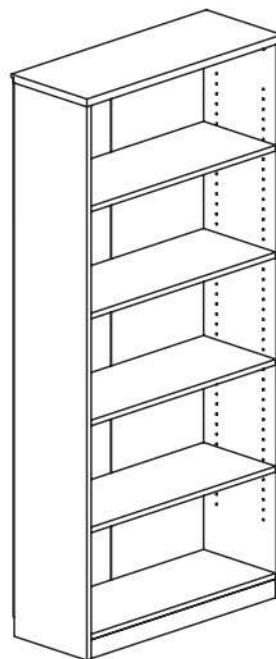

It is mandatory to affix the supplied permanent Warning Label to any toppling furniture covered by the Standard. The label must be placed in a visible location, ensuring it can be easily seen when the furniture is empty.
