

Safe Battery Disposal Advice



⚠ WARNING: FIRE HAZARD

DO NOT dispose of this product or its batteries in household garbage or recycling bins. Batteries can spark intense fires if crushed or damaged in waste trucks.

How to recycle:

Removable batteries	Remove from device and TAPE THE TERMINALS with clear sticky tape.
Embedded batteries	Do not attempt to remove. Where possible, ensure there is no more charge in the battery. Tape the charging port or connectors with clear sticky tape.
Large items with embedded batteries	If the product is too large for a standard retail collection bin (e.g. wireless floor lamp), DO NOT dismantle . Tape any exposed connectors and check with your local council for safe electronic waste (E-waste) collection options.

Find your nearest point:

For removable batteries, visit B-cycle. For other battery types, check Recycle Mate for recycling options or contact your local council.
